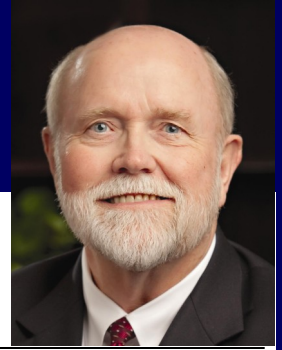

Background

Howard Marsee began practicing law in 1971 as a trial attorney. He has represented both plaintiffs and defendants in numerous areas of law. Since 1996, he has practiced as a mediator and an arbitrator in a wide variety of cases. He serves as special master in complex litigation. From approximately 1978- 1996, he concentrated on cases involving difficult medical issues and professional liability. He served as County Attorney in the 1970's.

Mr. Marsee was a board-certified civil trial lawyer for 20 years, from 1983-2003. He is certified by the Florida Supreme Court to receive circuit-civil mediation appointments. He is certified by the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Florida to receive mediation appointments in cases pending before that Court, and he is approved by the Florida 5th District Court of Appeal as an appellate mediator.

He has served as mediator for The Florida Bar's Grievance Mediation Program as well as an instructor for the Trial Advocacy Program. Mr. Marsee has authored numerous ordinances, special acts and land use regulations.
